



### Qualification and Registration Requirements

1. An applicant must fill the registration form and attach one-inch photo taken not more than six months prior to application date.
2. An applicant must ;
  - 2.1 Currently be pursuing either a bachelor (the 2<sup>nd</sup> year or above) or master's degree program in any fields
  - 2.2 Have recently graduated from either a bachelor or master's degree program in any fields
  - 2.3 Not be older than 28 years old at the time of application
3. An applicant must submit all required documents;
  - 3.1 **Verification of undergraduate or Master's degree** including the most recent official transcript and a confirmation letter from your institute
  - 3.2 **Curriculum Vitae**
  - 3.3 **Copied of passport**
  - 3.4 **Verification of English proficiency** (TOEFL, IELTS, TOEIC, or recommendation letter from the Dean)
  - 3.5 **The medical certificate in English** that he/she is in good health with no infectious or contagious disease
  - 3.6 **An essay** -minimum 1,000 words- in the topic of **“His Majesty the Late King Bhumibol Adulyadej and His Royal Initiatives in Nakhon Si Thammarat Province”**
  - 3.7 Two-minute **selfie video** to present yourself and your essay. The video to be posted on your facebook together with a hashtag **#wuculturalcamp**
4. An applicant must prepare a national costume for a performance at a reception party and/or farewell party.
5. Deadline for application submission is **15 May 2017**
6. An applicant must send the registration form including all required documents **by email**.
